

YANKEE CHAPTER TEST ENTRY RULES 2023

ENTRIES

Entries for the Spring and Fall tests will be accepted starting January 9, 2023 and end on February 10, 2023 for the lottery drawing. The lottery will be held on February 15, 2023 and entries received after the lottery will be placed on the waiting list if all test spots are filled by lottery entries.

- If applying for both the Spring and Fall tests, you will need to send two (2) separate envelopes and separate payments for each.
- If 2 entries are received in one envelope, the first test entry will be the only one accepted.
- Emailed/scanned entry forms or entry forms postmarked prior to January 1, 2023 will not be accepted.
- A dog that has already received a Prize 1 Utility score can only run again if it is to qualify/requalify for the Invitational, if its handler needs to test to fulfill judge or apprentice requirements, or if all the dogs on the waiting list who have not already received a Prize 1 have been admitted to a test.
 - Dogs that have already received a Prize 1 and are not requalifying for the Invitational or fulfilling a judge requirement will be placed on the bottom of the waiting list.

LOTTERY

Due to the high volume of test applications received in previous years, the test entry process will move to a lottery drawing. Completed Entry forms, test fees and NAVHDA member number are required in order for you to reserve a spot in the test. Entries received without this information will be deferred until the information is received with the exception of puppies from litters that have not yet been born or registered.

- The drawing will be held in mid-February with the Yankee Chapter board to ensure all entries are received for the drawing.
- Once the drawing is complete the Test Secretary will put the drawing order into the testing database and organize the tests based on the NAVHDA sanctioned test capacity chart.
- Once the database is loaded and handlers/dogs are assigned a testing date, the
 members will be notified of the running date or if they are on the waiting list. If the
 handler cannot make the date chosen, they will be placed at the bottom of the waiting
 list.

This process will provide the handlers that are on the waiting list an opportunity to apply for other Chapter tests to hopefully confirm a running position.

ELIGIBILITY

- Owners (or at least one owner of co-owned dogs) and any handler must be current NAVHDA International members in order to enter into a test and run a dog.
- No handler may run more than 2 dogs in either the spring or fall test.
- All dogs must be registered with NAVHDA. Only the dog registered for a test will be able to participate. No substitutions will be allowed.

REFUNDS

No entry fees will be refunded except in the following situations:

- (a) if an entry is filled with a replacement entry prior to 30 days before the test date
- (b) for a medical condition backed up by a doctor's or veterinarian's note
- (c) for entries on waiting list for which no room was found in a test.

If a handler/dog pulls from the test, their replacement, taken from the waiting list, will be placed at the bottom of the running order for that day.

FORMS

The link may change if and when NAVHDA updates the form.

- Fill out the test entry form and mail it to the Test Secretary. Please ensure all information you enter on the test entry form is accurate. This information is used to fill out the Judges' cards and to send final results into NAVHDA International.
- All names, whether dog or human, need to be their registered (with NAVHDA) name.
- The NAVHDA dog registration number is your dog's NAVHDA number that is on the Registration Certificate Pedigree you received from NAVHDA. If your dog is not registered, then do so by contacting the main office at (847) 253-6488 or email navhda@navhda.org.
- Your NAVHDA member number is located on the mailing label just above your name on the Versatile Hunting Dog Magazine. You can also locate both of these numbers online in the NAVHDA site.
- The form must be filled out completely and mailed to the Yankee Chapter Test Secretary.

TEST FEE

The test entry fee can be mailed, payable to Yankee Chapter of NAVHDA, Inc, or you can pay via PayPal. To reserve your place in a test; both the entry form and fee must be received. If your entry form is received without payment, your entry form <u>will not be processed</u> until payment is received.

If you use PayPal for your entry fee and pull from the test or do not get into the test, the PayPal service charge will be deducted from your refunded entry fee.
